A quote for \$2570.62 was received from ServePro to remediate a small mold issue in the equipment room and Preschool bathroom. The cost will be shared 50% by the church and 50% by the Preschool; therefore, a cost of \$1285.31 to the church.

Required HVAC repairs and repainting of the bathrooms were being assessed.

Senior Warden's Report (Bill Salter)

Leslie celebrated the Blessing of the Animals this past Sunday at the Services and Sunday Preschool. Attendance was light but well received.
